## Introduction

*Dear Brother Knights of Rizal Diamond Chapter and affiliated chapters in Belgium, Europe and worldwide,*

*We are rapidly coming the end of this remarkable year in with we celebrated the 150<sup>th</sup> birth-day of the national hero Dr. José Rizal earlier this year.*

*On Dec. 30<sup>th</sup>, which is declared Rizal day in the Philippines, traditionally we commemorate his execution in 1896. But this year, that date is another exceptional milestone in the history of the KNIGHTS OF RIZAL.*

*Exactly 100 years ago, on Dec 30<sup>th</sup>, 1911, the **ORDEN DE CABALLEROS DE RIZAL** has been founded by a small group of people with one major objective: Keep the memory of Rizal and his philosophy alive so that his lofty ideas do not go to waste. Over the years, the order changed its name to its English translation **KNIGHTS OF RIZAL** and expanded its goals. The order received a legal character and official recognition by the Republic Act no. 646 on June 16, 1951 or 60 year ago.*

*History has taught us that Rizal's ideas were not only applicable to his countrymen, but also to people everywhere. They are not only universal, but even up to today they are still actual. This was probably partially the result of his genius analysis of human interactions during his travels around the world.*

*Therefore it is not surprising that, after a full century, the order keeps on growing and that knights are spreading all over the world, especially at the places where Rizal lived, studied, worked or at places he visited.*

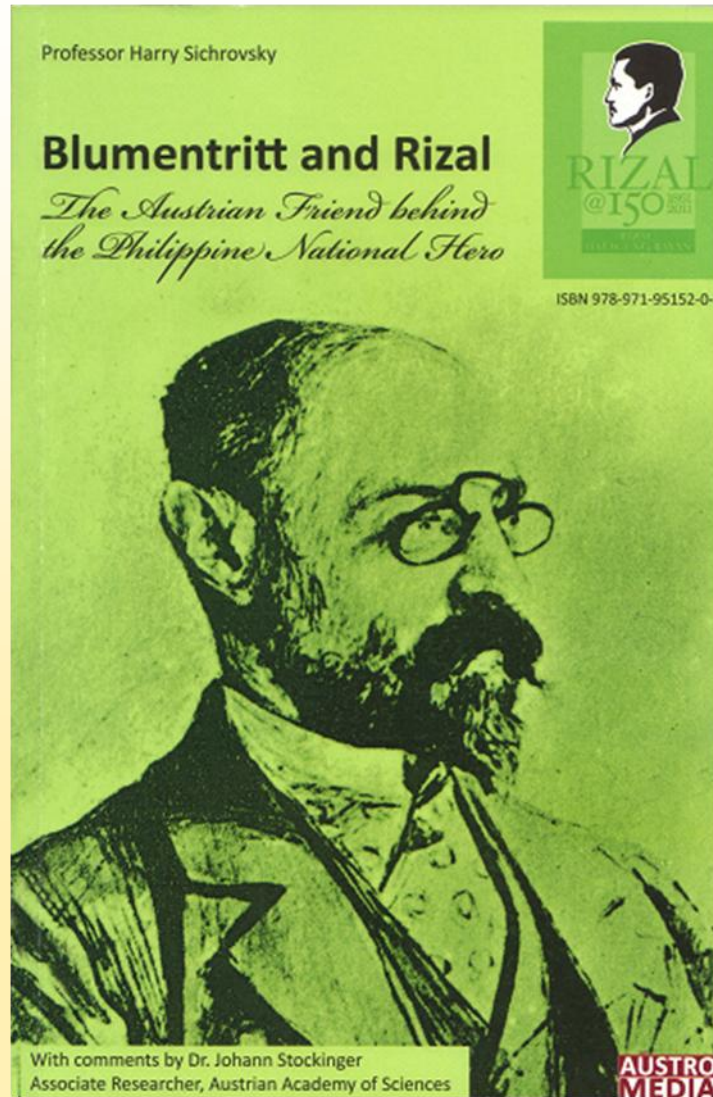

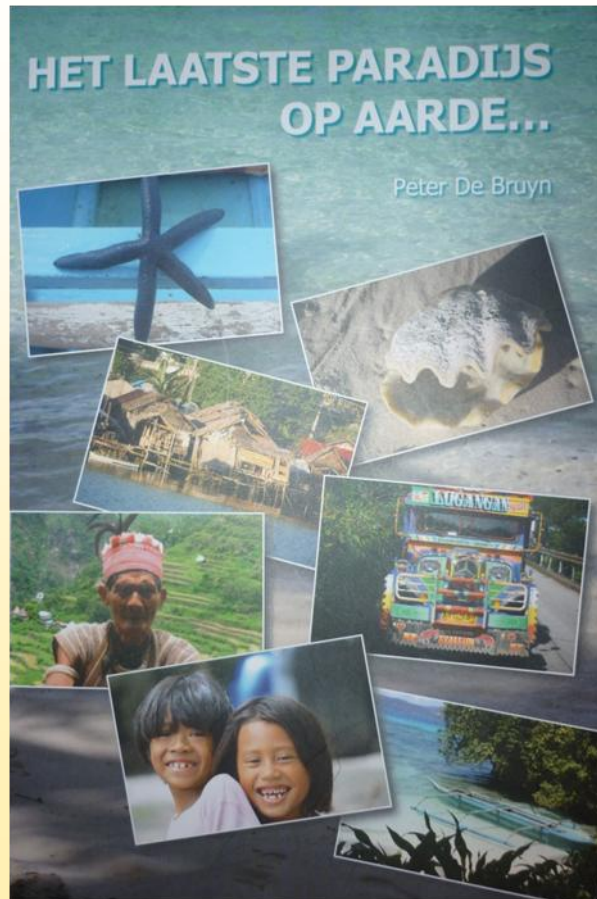

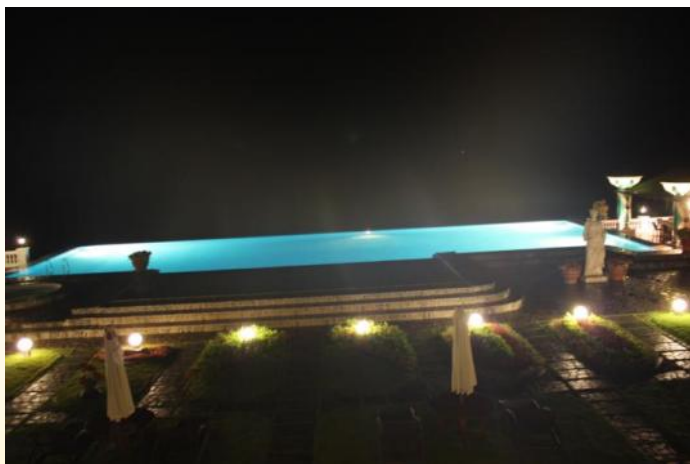
